



Old Basing Infant School Uniform Policy



School Uniform

The school uniform colours are bright green and grey. The green sweatshirt or green cardigan, with the school's logo, can be purchased online or in store from [Skoolkit](#). Skirts and trousers are grey. A white shirt or polo shirt may be worn under the school sweatshirt. Alternatively, a white polo shirt embroidered with the school's logo can be bought at [Skoolkit](#) but this is **optional**. Socks/tights should be moderate colours (e.g black, grey or white) and shoes must be sturdy, with closed in toes and appropriate for outdoor play.

[Skoolkit](#) provide a wide range of other pieces of uniform appropriate to Old Basing Infant School, such as grey trousers, grey skirts and pinafores, green summer dresses and grey shorts, along with book bags and PE kit items with the school logo. These items are **optional** and can be purchased from anywhere. There is no requirement from the school for parents to provide any uniform with the school logo on other than the school sweatshirt/cardigan.

Uniform for school should be chosen so that:

- Children can easily dress themselves
- It is easy to launder
- Is of a reasonable price to assist with affordability
- It is suitable for the weather

Please make sure every item of clothing is **clearly marked** with your child's name.

P.E. Kit

P.E kit should be as follows:

- Black jogging bottoms
- White T-shirt
- Black shorts
- Trainers
- Usual school jumper or cardigan

In YR children will get changed for P.E in order to assist them in developing the physical skills required for dressing and undressing. This is a skill they should be able to master before progressing to KS1.

All P.E. clothing should be **clearly marked** with your child's name and kept in a drawstring bag. Please keep P.E. kit in school at all times.

Whilst PE kit bags are available on the Skoolkit website there is no requirement for these logoed items to be purchased. They can wear any black shorts or joggers and a plain white t-shirt as listed for KS1 above.

KS1 (Years 1 and 2)

Children in KS1 should come to school dressed in their P.E kit on their P.E days. These days will be timetabled and communicated to parents at the start of each new year. There is no need to provide a hoodie for P.E as the normal school jumper will be worn.

Jewellery

No jewellery including earrings should be worn in school for Health & Safety reasons. The school follows County Policy that no earrings may be worn during P.E. sessions. Parents should remove their child's earrings before school on PE days.
