

Car Park Advice to Parents

1. Only use your car to drop off your children if absolutely necessary.
2. If you do use the car, consider parking away from the school at the recommended areas such as the British Legion Car Park.
3. Allow plenty of time - the school will always be congested at the beginning and end of the day and your journey will not always turn out as planned.
4. Only allow children to leave from the near side doors and only at the points where school staff are positioned to assist them and ensure they move quickly to the paved areas.
5. Never walk through the car park among traffic movements. Use the paved areas and designated crossing points.
6. Do not overtake in the drive-through area.
7. Do not remain in the drive-through area. Once your children have been discharged, leave the area as quickly and as safely as possible.
8. Do not park up between the hours of 0830 and 0900 unless absolutely necessary. If you do need to park, please park by reversing into the designated parking spaces. All current advice suggests this is the safest way as it gives full visibility when leaving and ensures that you do not reverse blindly into oncoming traffic or into the path of pedestrians in this congested area. Please accept that if you do park, you will not have priority on leaving. This will be given to cars dropping off children to prevent backing up onto the main roads.
