

Risk Assessment Information for Visitors – COVID-19 – September 2021 – Update February 2022

Whilst the use of face covering is no longer advised in this setting, any visitor who wishes to use this precaution whilst moving around the school building is free to do so.

Transmission through the air	H	visitors	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tissues in every room being used – hands to be sanitised or washed after using a tissue • Windows and internal and external doors open if possible for ventilation • Visitors to maintain 2m social distancing with all adults and children whilst inside the school building 	L
Transmission via objects	H	visitors	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hand sanitiser to be used before signing in and on leaving • Minimal resources brought into school • Meeting room surfaces and high touch areas to be cleaned before and after any meeting 	L
Adults visiting classes	H	visitors	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Individuals to take responsibility for their own safety • Keep contact to a minimum 	L
Clinically vulnerable adults at greater risk	H	visitors	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Visitors with long term health conditions to complete own risk assessment before attending school 	L
Over-crowded toilets for adults	H	visitors	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Adults not to queue in staff toilets • Wait outside • No more than 2 people in the toilets at any one time 	L
Evacuation for fire etc (See Health and Safety information given by the office prior to starting)	H	Visitors	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Visitors to be informed of the assembly point and procedure on arrival 	L
